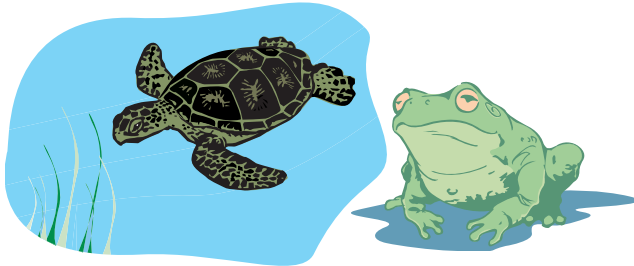
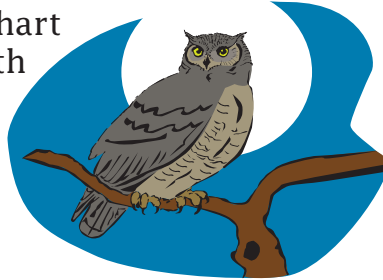

Winter Programs for 2012

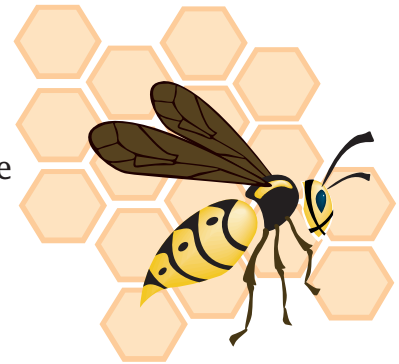


Saturday, January 21 - Drew Carhart speaks about **Outdoor Lighting** with special emphasis on the effects of artificial light on our outdoor environment.
